Steve leaves Wednesday for PNG! On Sunday, our church had a special time to focus on Steve's consulting trip. They prayed for him and for the work he'll be doing with the Malei and Yamap teams and asked for God's blessings on the trip. He'll be quality-checking the Yamap gospel of Luke and the 2nd half of the Malei book of Psalms. He returns on October 8th.

Carol Jean will be attending meetings with many other members of Wycliffe USA in Orlando August 31st - September 2nd. The first day they will have team meetings, and the other two days will address strategies for global partnerships. It will be great to gather in person with colleagues that she rarely sees or sees only on Zoom.

After the Wycliffe meetings she will spend a few days with her parents in Wisconsin.

Steve's bus made a brief stop on the 6hour trip through the highlands of PNG. (The scenery is lacking its usual greenness due to moderate drought conditions in many areas)

By God's grace, Steve made it to his final destination (Lae, Papua New Guinea) in one piece with all his bags 1½ days later than expected. Because the Lae airport closed just as he was arriving in PNG, he rerouted to a different town, and the last leg of his journey was a bumpy and crowded 6-hour small bus ride.

Steve had planned to start checking the Gospel of Luke with the Yamap team Monday, but this was postponed a day due to his unexpected travel delays. Not all of the Yamap and other language teams have arrived to the Bible translation workshop yet. Some come by sea and some by vehicle from many hours away.

In addition to the two projects Steve is checking for at this month's workshop, there are about four other language projects working on their translations with advisors and consultants.

Carol Jean was encouraged and inspired at the Wycliffe meetings she attended in Orlando last week. It was great to hear from representatives of partner organizations around the world how God is

at work to bring his Word to those who still don't have it in the language that speaks best to their hearts.

She is now in Wisconsin until September 13th.

Greetings from Minnesota, friends! We made the arduous journey from Gembu to the States and survived it once again! We left our home in Gembu on June 6 and arrived at our Pine River MN home around 11:00 on June 9. We packed up our bags and headed out to drive to the Reach Conference on June 11. We attended the Converge Global Leaders' Summit, which was wonderful to get to connect with our fellow Global Workers from around the World, and then we attended the Reach Conference, which was a great encouragement and inspiration to us. We got to share an AirBNB with John and Karen Ames and enjoyed getting to know our Converge Africa Impact Team Leaders even better! We left Colorado on June 23 and met our friend Nathan in Kansas City on the 25 to talk about how we could get an Agriculture program going in Nigeria. We got to update to our

Galesburg IL church on June 26 and meet with the Mission's team. We left our friend Dee's house in Galesburg on June 27 and arrived back in Pine River that night.

We are thankful for great connections, safety, and encouragement during this time! On Independence Day we got to celebrate with Tina's mom and sisters, as well as our older son, Andrew. Our hearts are very full!

We haven't confirmed our schedule for September yet and are going back to Gembu in October.

We will need to renew our Visas again when we return to Nigeria, please pray that it is a smooth process. We are also still working on the duty waiver for the container.

Some of our staff are going through a Discipleship Bible Study. The week we left we introduced the material and had 7 people in attendance. That number has increased to 12 over the last 4 weeks. That means there are now 12 people learning how to disciple others. We are excited to see what this will look like when we return to Nigeria.
