Once again time has flown by here in Gembu! I am amazed at how each

week zooms by!

First, we want to thank each of you who gave during our special "Giving Tuesday" Opportunity! We were amazed and so blessed that we were able to give 40 families over 2 weeks of food. We surprised each of them by just showing up at their houses, visiting with them, explaining we wanted to share Jesus' love with them during this hard time, sharing the gospel with them, praying, and sharing the food items. There was laughter, tears, hugs, and much appreciation! so wish each of you could have gone with us and heard the stories and experience these families for yourselves. It was a blessing to get to be a part of this!

The response was much more than we anticipated! We are going to be able to bless many more families over the next months! We will take about 10 families monthly until our funds are depleted. We think we may be able to do 6 more months! Thank you again for helping us care for the hurting and hungry in Gembu!

Our Thursday Bible Study group has finished the Zume training, and we have been doing a study called, "Christian". It is very powerful and we are having wonderful conversations about what that looks like currently in our area of the world and what God thinks it should look like! We are so blessed by thoughtful, Godly staff on our Leadership Team and Bible Study Group!

During the entire month of December, Tina did our Staff Devotions using the John Piper Good News of Great Joy! Advent Devotional book gifted to us before we left to return to Gembu. In studying and preparing Tina really gained a much richer, deeper understanding and both of us did the same devotional together after breakfast. Many of the staff commented that they have never prepared their hearts before, only their houses and food. I believe Advent Devotions are going to be a meaningful tradition for our staff from now on. It was a wonderful experience for our staff to do this together. Dan put the PDF Version (which is free from the Desiring God website) on our WhatsApp Staff Group. This was an unexpected blessing during this Christmas and New Year season!

We have finally finished our process to start a new Board of Trustees. We had our second meeting in December and are so excited to have 5 Nigerians, and the two of us on the Board to help guide the organization forward! This process has taken about 6 years to accomplish! I am not sure if we have ever shared this before, but NOTHING moves quickly here in Nigeria!

Speaking of that, we are still working on the duty waiver......

Things are moving forward here in Gembu, our staff is doing a wonderful job of moving the organization forward and we are thankful! This

week we are interviewing for some new staff members to help with some of the new grants we have received. Our leadership team at GECHAAN has been able to secure 4 grants, one of them lasting 4 years, to help us work with the influx of refugees we have been having. This will allow us to have a greater impact in our county. Giving us a greater voice to share the gospel message!

Exodus is moving things forward in the AWANA program. We are having a three-day training for new clubs at the end of January and are planning on an AWANA Olympics, Bible Story, and Verse competition early in March. He is busy going and meeting with Pastors during the days and attending Clubs, mentoring and training new workers at the various churches during the late afternoons and evenings. We are so thankful for this work. He dreams of starting AWANA clubs in churches all over the Plateau!
