### **Missionary Reports**

<u>Amy Hedstrand</u> is a teacher in Bogota, Columbia. She teaches English, Christian Education and is homeroom teacher for the 9th grade. She adopted a Colombian girl named Tayley, who is being home schooled this year.

Amy said they had completed another step in the process of getting paperwork done for Tayley and will wait for the next step. They are continuing to work with the United States requirements to bring Tayley to the states. <u>Steve and Carol Jean Gallagher</u> are Wycliffe Bible Translators in Papua, New Guinea. They have translated Genesis, Exodus, and all of the New Testament into the Bariai language.

Steve is doing consultant checking for other languages which are being translated and will return in October to consult check the gospel of Matthew for the Mussau language.

They are delighted to find that many people are using the audio scriptures. Only the books of Matthew and Acts remain unfinished.

There are several Bariai people who are eager to share God's truth among the Bariai people.

Please pray that more Bariai people would gain a true understanding of why God sent the Gallagher's to live and work with them. Also pray that the Bariai people would change or discard practices, such as sorcery, that are not in line with the Bible and for Steve's translation consultant checking in October.

<u>Dan and Tina Gibbs</u> report that things **are** peaceful and going well. We are working very hard on putting into practice new procedures on preventing theft from the clinic, guest house and restaurant.

I have been meeting with pastors introducing them to AWANA, woman's groups and Days for Girls project. On the Standing Beside facebook page you can read our newsletter. We really love and miss our Christian Camper friends this summer. We are so thankful for your prayers.

<u>Earl and Bev Rutledge family</u> are continuing to teach and translate in seminars for pastors and their wives and other church leaders from various denominations in different cities in Nicaragua.

In April, they attended Judah's graduation with honors from Letourneau University in Texas. Luke is traveling to Taiwan for two months with Youth With a Mission.

Bev traveled to Minnesota to see her parents in June. Her father continues dialysis four hours 3 days a week. His last checkup showed that he continues to be cancer free.

Earl will be training in Seattle in August and will take a ministry trip to Bolivia in September.

They are asking for prayer for wisdom in choosing commitments, for travel safety, for Bev's parent's health, for Travel expenses and for the healing of Earl's left eye.
